This is a public notice that the City of Corona's Planning and Housing Commission will conduct a public hearing in the City Hall Council Chambers, 400 S. Vicentia Avenue, Corona, on Tuesday, November 13, 2018, at 6:00 p.m. or thereafter upon the following:

CUP17-002: An application to establish a 2.5 million gallon potable water tank on 0.90 acres located at 3985 Nelson Street in the R-1A (Single-Family Residential, 40,000 square-foot minimum lot size) Zone and consideration of a Mitigated Negative Declaration regarding potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed application project.

V2017-0101: An application for a variance to increase the height of a perimeter tube steel fence from seven feet to eight feet for a new city water reservoir site proposed on the southeast corner of Nelson Street and Keith Street (3985 Nelson Street) in the R-1A (Single-Family Residential, 40,000 square-foot minimum lot size) Zone, and consideration of a Mitigated Negative Declaration regarding potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed application. Project associated with CUP17-002.
