The City of Corona is soliciting proposals from nonprofit fair housing organizations to provide fair housing and landlord-tenant mediation services during the 2019-20 and 2020-21 Program Years spanning July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2021. Applicants shall be qualified fair housing organizations pursuant to 24 CFR 125.103. This is a one-year funding opportunity with an option for renewal for a second year. The source of funds for this grant is federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Grant renewal is contingent upon the applicant fulfilling the requested services and meeting contracted program goals and requirements for subrecipients of CDBG funds during the first year of the grant.

The scope of services requested under this grant includes the provision of fair housing anti-discrimination education, intake and case management; landlord-tenant education, intake and case management; and enforcement activities as necessary for bona-fide complaints. Services may be provided from the fair housing organization's office(s). The City is requesting that applicants offer on-site office hours and in-person services for a minimum of 4 hours per week at a City-provided facility to facilitate community access to the fair housing organization's services.

Subsequent to the application deadline, the Community Development Department will review all applications and make a funding recommendation to the City Council as part of the 2019-20 Action Plan. This is a HUD-funded grant opportunity and funding availability is subject to the City receiving CDBG funds from HUD.
