



## EMERGENCY HOUSING NEEDS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (EHNAP)

On June 3, 2020, the Corona City Council approved the EHNAP. The program is federally funded. It's available to Corona renters, financially impacted by COVID-19, to assist with rental and utility payments.

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

1. **Who can apply for EHNAP assistance?** City of Corona renters.
2. **Are there other eligibility criteria?** Yes. Renters must meet income qualifications and financial impacts must be as a result of COVID-19.
3. **What are examples of COVID-19 impacts?** Examples included, but are not limited to, loss of employment, reduction of work hours, reduced wages.
4. **How much financial assistance is available?** Up to \$6,000. A needs analysis will be conducted to determine how much assistance is needed for rent and utility payments.
5. **Is the assistance a loan or a grant?** Grant.
6. **How can I apply and what information is needed?**
  - Complete the EHNAP Application, link below. Income documentation, rental/lease agreement and proof of COVID-19 impact required. Read the guidelines attached to application for a full list of requirements.
  - Application and Guidelines will be mailed upon request.
7. **How do I submit my application packet?** By mail or person.
  - **Mail to:** City of Corona – see mail address below
  - **In Person:** Submit application at Corona City Hall - Community Development Dept. See address below.
8. **How will applications be processed?** Funds are limited. Therefore, the first 100 applications will be accepted, date stamped and processed in the order received.
9. **How soon will I know if I'm approved?** Staff will review applications and respond within 14 calendar days, or earlier. If your application is incomplete, you will be given 7 calendar days to submit the missing paperwork.
10. **If I'm approved, are grant funds sent directly to me?** No. In accordance with HUD rules, City staff will pay your landlord and utility companies directly.
