The City of Corona Department of Water and Power (CDWP) currently provides safe, reliable power to more than 1,700 accounts throughout the City of Corona on a daily basis. This month, we are pleased to bring you this Power Content Label, as designed by the California Energy Commission (CEC).

The table below is an effort to keep you, the customer, informed about the various fuel sources used to produce the power we use in California and the City of Corona.
