



## Historic Building Survey Collection

*c. 1975-2017, bulk of documents from 1980s.*

*4927 textual documents, 93 photographs | 5.5 linear feet | 9 binders, 10 boxes*

The Historic Building Survey Collection is largely composed of historic building surveys which identified and documented early historic buildings in Corona. Two surveys were conducted. One directed by former Heritage Room Librarian Gloria Scott Freel and conducted by volunteers in 1982-1983 identified approximately 400 historical properties located primarily in the downtown core. The second survey, conducted by the firm AEGIS in 1986 added another 286 properties to Freel's survey. The AEGIS report concluded that the city's land use policies were inadvertently promoting the destruction of the city's historic buildings. The city responded to the AEGIS report by taking two actions in 1988. First, it adopted a demolition delay ordinance which required a 90 day waiting period prior to issuing a demolition permit for structures listed on the historic surveys or Freel and AEGIS. Second, it rezoned the historic downtown residential neighborhoods from R-3 (multiple family residential) to R-1-7.2 (single family residential) in order to preserve the area's single family homes. In June, 2001, the Historic Resources Element was added to the city's General Plan and an implementing ordinance became chapter 17.63 of the Corona Municipal Code. The Element identified local preservation efforts and issues and delineated goals and policies for the conservation and management of historic resources in the City of Corona. Chapter 17.63 established a Corona Register of Historic Resources and the Corona Heritage Inventory.

The collection is arranged in two series: properties and administrative. The bulk of the collection consists of architectural surveys, information on the specific buildings in the surveys in the form of newspaper articles and written narratives. City Council actions related to the historic property are included in this collection. Historic nomination applications are included along with all relevant information used to apply for historic status. Each building survey has a black and white 3.5" x 5" photo of the property. Some properties that were proposed for demolition contain historic resource evaluation reports. The administrative series contains address lists of properties included in the surveys as well as properties that were not included. Samples of materials that were used in the building surveys are in the collection. Final survey reports are in the collection as well as City Council Historic Element actions.

The collection serves as an aid for researching historic buildings in the downtown Corona area. The collection spans 1975 to 2015 with the bulk of the material from the 1980s when both historic building surveys were conducted.
