

**RESOLUTION NO. 2013-027**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORONA, CALIFORNIA, REVISING THE CITYWIDE MASTER FEE RECOVERY SCHEDULE AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NOS. 2011-019, 2012-023, 2012-048, AND 2013-023**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 3.02 of the Corona Municipal Code (“CMC”) establishes the percentages of cost recovery relating to the schedule of fees and service charges; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2011-019 previously established the Master Fee Resolution for all fees and charges provided for in Chapter 3.02 of the Corona Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2012-023 previously established a new fee for news rack permits, Resolution No. 2012-048 previously established a new fee for online registration and reservations, and Resolution No. 2013-023 previously established a new fee for cottage food operation permits; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to repeal and replace Resolution Nos. 2011-019, 2012-023, 2012-048, and 2013-023 with this new Master Fee Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the new Master Fee Resolution includes California Proposition 26, Article XII C Section (e) exemption categories; and

**WHEREAS**, a properly noticed public hearing was held on April 3, 2013, to receive public comments on the proposed schedule of fees and charges.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Corona, California, as follows:

**SECTION 1. Adoption of Fees and Charges.** The fees and charges set forth in Exhibit “A” attached hereto and made a part hereof are approved, and shall take effect and be in force according to law.

**SECTION 2. Repeal of Prior Resolutions.** Resolution Nos. 2011-019, 2012-023, 2012-048, and 2013-023 are hereby repealed and replaced by this new Master Fee Resolution.


**SECTION 3. Supporting Evidence & Study.** The adoption of this Resolution is based on all oral and written evidence presented to the City, including the cost detail worksheets dated January 2013 and prepared by Revenue Costs Specialists, with the assistance and final review by all affected departments, as well as all oral and written evidence presented to

the City for this Resolution. The cost detail worksheets, which documents that all approved fees and charges do not exceed the cost to the City of providing the noted services, is hereby accepted by the City Council.


**SECTION 4. CEQA Findings.** The City Council hereby finds that, in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") and the CEQA Guidelines, the adoption of this Resolution is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3).

**SECTION 5. Effective Date of Resolution.** The Mayor shall sign this Resolution and the Chief Deputy City Clerk shall attest thereto, and thereafter this Resolution shall take effect on July 1, 2013.


